**Market Animals must be inspected before unloading and will go directly to scale for weigh in as organized by specie committee and Jr. Fair Coordinator. Tag in for Goats & Hogs also.**

**No Market Showmanship. Ribbons to be requested through Bonnie Schuck Deadline: 8/5/20  
Carcass Classes will continue; suggest not dating awards, etc. in case of last minute changes.**

**Judges: Senior Fair Board will pay up to\* \$250, committee will need to cover any costs above.  
\*Normal judging pay scale to be taken into consideration i.e., if judge costs \$75 in 2019 that will be the approximate” normal pay scale.**

**Live Auctions Location TBD Only Registered Bidders permitted with social distancing seating.  
Pre-Registration for Auctions along with Proxy Bidders for those unable to attend**

**NO Animals will go into sale ring for Beef, Swine, Goats, Lambs, SAC Poultry. Sale order will be Grand & Reserve, Carcass champions where applicable followed by pre-determined by family units.**

**Limit of spectators to Jr. Fair Exhibitor and immediate family members – social distancing and face masks as required by fair week will be followed along with all State & County Health Department Regulations in place fair week.**

**Each species will be responsible for complete barn & pen clean out including manure for pre-fair, fair week, post fair plus show/barn set-up with assistance from Fair Volunteers and Board members as available.**
