- 10. Stake Bends (may be canceled if less than 5 entries)
- 11. Speed & Control (may be canceled if less than 5 entries)

Ribbons are awarded $1^{st} - 6^{th}$ and High Point for each show

High Point classes:

Walk/Trot: 12,13,14,15,16, 15 & under: 1,3,5,7,9,10,11 16 & over: 2,4,6,8,9,10,11

Concession stand will be open.

This is NOT a 4-H show; however the Portage County Equine Show Committee shows will be following the Ohio 4-H State rule book, except for age. ALL participants 19 years and under are required to wear a ASTM/SEI approved protective headgear. Walk/Trot exhibitors are not permitted to canter at this show. Proper attire, proper tack, only legal bits and proper conduct of participants and spectators.

The show committee reserves the right to combine, split or cancel classes. No entry fee will be refunded without proof of illness to horse or rider. No entry fee will be refunded due to weather conditions. Any unruly horse, pony, or person will be excused from the grounds. No alcohol is permitted on the grounds.

Neither the Portage County Equine Show Committee, Randolph Fair Board, nor any other organization or individual associated with the show will assume any responsibility for injury or death to horse, rider or spectator or responsibility to loss or stolen property.
