Classes in Ring A will be single judged, with an opportunity to show under a second judge if needed. Gymkhana Show #2 is offered since you may have only one run at a show to qualify, we offer the required two shows for Gymkhana classes with one judge per show. Attached you will find a class selection sheet for the State Fair Qualification and your pre-entry sheet. Please fill out all information and return it no later than **June 11th**.

Mail registration form and payment (checks only) to: Portage County Saddle Club 2433 State Route 44, Atwater, OH 44201. You will be charged a \$20.00 fee for NSF checks in addition to any bank fees charged to Saddle Club.

The pre-registration fee is \$8.00 per class selected. Payment is required with registration. Make checks payable to Portage County 4-H Horse Committee. Same day registration is not recommended, as classes will be \$10.00 each. Anyone planning on showing from a different county will be charged \$10.00 per class. You may select up to **eight** classes to participate in at the selection show. In order to attend the State Fair you will be required to qualify in two classes, you are eligible to enter **four** classes at the state fair if you qualify in them at the PAS show, plus ground roping. **All riders must be considered Intermediate or Advanced to participate in this show. Walk-Trot and Novice riders are permitted to participate in ground classes.**

Members will pay an entry fee for showing under each judge.

Please reference Page 11 of the Uniform Rules for 4-H Horse Shows, Rule #37. Exhibitors must choose one discipline within each riding style at a horse show. Within English they must choose Saddle Seat or Hunt. Within Western they must choose Western or Ranch. This selection also includes showmanship classes.

Ground roping: Youth wanting to show in Ground Roping only at the State Fair Junior Horse Show are required to qualify in that class at a PAS show but are not required to qualify in any other PAS horse classes. All exhibitors wanting to show ground roping at state fair must be enrolled in the roping project book and submit their completed project book to the show office the morning of the Ground Roping class for scoring which will count towards their overall class placing. Ground Roping book will also be required to bring to State Fair show.

Any riders currently holding a rotating trophy must return the trophy at the PAS Show. All trophies not returned by PAS show will be charged \$50 fee.

4-H members who intend to show at the Ohio State Fair Junior Horse Show must upload a copy of their equine's current negative Coggins test (dated on or after January 1, 2025) to their 4-H Online account by July 1st. You must also upload your Equistep certificate, horse ID form, and be a member in good standing.

The dates for this year's Ohio State Fair Junior Horse Show are Monday, July 14th through Friday, July 18th. We will be able to move into the fairgrounds on Sunday after 6:00pm this year but a time has not been decided yet. A copy of the show schedule is posted online at horse.osu.edu.

Camping at the Ohio State Fair Junior Horse show will be accepting reservations on first come first serve basis. Registration forms will be accepted beginning 5/5/25. There will be no lottery for camping at State Fair.

The online registration deadline for the Ohio State Fair Junior Horse Show is Monday, July 1, 2025. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to submit their entry and pay their \$50 stall fee online at www.ohiostatefair.com by 1:00 pm on July 1, 2025.
