

**Portage County Randolph Fair
Junior Fair Board
List of Requirements**

Junior Fair Board members must be at least 14 years and not over 19 years of age on January 1 of the year they are selected to serve. ** Past active members may continue active membership until the age of 21.

**Meetings are mandatory. Missing more than three meetings or portions of more than three meetings or work nights can result in dismissal. Meetings may be added by advisors and officers as needed.*

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| Meetings are: | March-May | 3 rd Wednesday of the month |
| | June | 1 st and 3 rd Wednesdays of the month |
| | July | At least two Weds. TBD depending on July 4 th and 4-H Camp |
| | August | Every Wednesday and daily starting Sunday, prior to Fair Week |
| | September | 3 rd Wednesday of the month |

- If representing 4-H you must be enrolled and participating in a project area for the 2025 fair. If representing an organization other than 4-H, that organization must be participating in the current year's fair.
- You must work a minimum of 24 hours (of Junior Fair Board work hours) during fair week or you will be dismissed as a member of the board.
- You must serve on at least one planning committee.
- You may be removed at any time during the year for inappropriate, unacceptable behavior or for not fulfilling duties, as determined by Junior Fair Board Advisors and Senior Fair Board Executive Committee.
