- 2. The application and attachments MUST be received at the Portage County Randolph Fair Office by the 3rd Wednesday of July...2025 July 16th
- 3. Applicants MUST have at least a 2.25 accumulative GPA or above to receive the Scholarship and be enrolled/accepted at an accredited college or technical school.

*Once awarded the scholarship: YOU MUST present a copy of a receipt/statement of account (bill) as proof of enrollment from the accredited college or technical school. No money will be distributed until proof is submitted to the Sale Committee Treasurer. NO checks will be issued before September 30th. All receipts MUST be turned in for reimbursement by December 31st of the year, in which the scholarship was granted.
