Buyer Registration

Market Livestock Buyers: Previous year registered buyers will receive a mailing that explains buyer registration for this year's fair.

For new buyers, you will come to the buyer registration table on sale day and complete paperwork. You will need to provide general information, driver's license, and a working email address. At this time, you will also select your processor (not needed for rabbit & poultry purchases).

ADD-ON Option: A registered buyer can add an additional dollar amount to any exhibitor's market livestock sale.

Add-Ons can be done online at
pcrandolphjrfair.fairentry.com.

This can be completed starting August 23rd through August 30th. **If you are creating a new buyer's account for only add-ons do not add an identifier (buyer number).**

DONATING BACK your livestock auction purchase(s): If you do not want the meat from a purchase you can donate your purchased animal(s) for a **2nd sale** with those proceeds being donated to a Jr. Fair Livestock fund that you choose. When you register you will need to inform the sale clerk that you want to donate back for 2nd sale. You will have a buyer paddle with a letter added to your buyer number that represents the fund the 2nd sale proceeds will be donated to. This bidder number will be used to choose the donated back option for that purchase.

Buyers wishing to keep all meat from purchases will have one bidder number.

General Information and Benefits

You are cordially invited to participate in this year's market livestock auctions during the Portage County Randolph Fair. The Jr. Fair auctions give you, as an individual or as a business, an opportunity to promote your services and/or support local youth. The youth who bring market animal projects have dedicated their time and energies to care for their project(s) and to also learn about their animal(s). Raising an animal creates many valuable lessons and through these projects they learn about agribusiness, quality assurance, livestock judging, marketing and working together. They also develop a strong work ethic and will use this knowledge in the future which will make our community better.

The youth, who participate in these projects, rely upon the funds received from the auction to pay off investments and production costs and most will invest their profits in their future education. We are lucky to have many past participants return as adults to be advisors, volunteers, mentors, and supporters of the auctions.

Buyers names/business name will be included in future promotional releases. 2026 buyers will receive a sale day admission pass for the fair in a special mailing prior to 2027 fair.

Options of What to Do with Animal After Purchase

1. Send your animal to be processed by one of the available/approved processors. Purchaser pays for processing directly to processor, except rabbits & poultry.**

**All Poultry and Rabbits are processed at committee selected facilities. The processing fee will be added to the invoice for the auctions. Poultry and Rabbits will be picked up after the fair on an assigned date at the fairgrounds.

2. You can purchase an animal and donate it back to be sold a second time. You will pay the total bid price for the first sale with those proceeds going to the Jr. Fair Exhibitor. The money from the second sale will be given to the Jr. Fair Livestock Fund you select. A list of these funds will be available at the buyer registration table. Examples: Livestock Sale Scholarship, 4-H Scholarship, Dan Tronge Scholarship, or a 4-H club involved in market livestock projects.

3. ALL HOGS, POULTRY, RABBITS, BEEF STEERS & CHAMPIONS OF ALL SPECIES ARE TERMINAL. Market ewe lambs, doe goats & beef heifers can be purchased & self hauled (Buyer is responsible to remove from fairgrounds). Wether goats & lambs can be self hauled, but must be harvested within 45 days of auction. Sale Clerk **must** be notified by buyer on sale day so proper paperwork can be obtained for self haul at check out.

4. You can donate the animal/meat to a local food shelf. The buyer is responsible for processing costs & delivery to selected food shelf. You **MUST** make notation on buyer registration if you choose this option.

ADD-ON OPTION: A registered buyer can add an additional dollar amount to exhibitor(s). This option is available online starting on Aug. 23rd - Aug. 30th pcrandolphjrfair.fairentry.com

How to Buy and Terms of the Sale

1. All previous year buyers will receive a pre-assigned bidder number. If you are a new buyer you will need to complete buyer registration at the Buyer Registration table beginning approximately 1 hour prior to the auctions. General information needed: buyer's name, address, phone number, Driver's license and an active email address. If a business, we will need the name of business, contact person's name, business address, phone number, email address and Driver's license for the authorized bidder.

Prospective buyers must also select a meat processor unless purchasing only small animals, or donating purchases back for second sale. Animals may only be donated back one time. On the day of the auction, you will pick up your bidder number at the appropriate table.

2. As each animal is sold, the auctioneer or ring men will take bids. Whether or not you are successful in purchasing the animal, your bid helps the Jr. Fair youth & Market Livestock Auction.

3. When you have finished purchasing, you will need to proceed to the Sale Office and pay for your purchases. At this time, if planning to self-haul eligible purchases, the required paperwork must be obtained.

4. You **MUST** pay for the purchases the day of the sale. Payment can be made with Cash, "Good" check or credit card. There is a credit card processing fee that will be added to all credit card purchases.
